

AIM: To practise listening to middle sounds in words.

Card 32 **Memory – Middle Sound Match**

1. Work with a partner.
2. Spread the cards out face down on the table.
3. Take turns to choose two cards.
- 4. Say each picture aloud and listen for the middle sound.**
5. If the words have the same middle sound they match and you can keep the cards.
6. If your cards match have another turn.
7. If the cards do not match return them face down to the same position.
8. If the cards do not match, your partner has a turn.
9. The winner is the player with the most cards at the end of the game.

AIM: To practise listening for the onset in words.

Card 33 **Memory – Onset Match**

1. Work with a partner.
2. Spread the cards out face down on the table.
3. Take turns to choose two cards.
- 4. Say each picture aloud and listen for the beginning sounds [onset]. The beginning sound may represent 2 or 3 letters.**
5. If the onset matches on both cards, keep the cards and have another turn.
6. If the onset does not match, your partner has a turn.
7. The person with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.
