



## TEACHER TIP – Magic Fan:

Make Card 7 by laminating and cutting out each strip. Hold them like a fan and ask the children to choose one. Children may like to add extra strips to the collection by writing and drawing their own ideas.

### Card 7 Magic Fan

1. Ask the teacher or a partner to hold the strips in a fan.

2. Say the chant as you choose a strip.

*“Magic Fan, Magic Fan*

*Pick a picture*

*Write about it, if you can!”*

3. Look at your picture on the strip and think about it.

4. Now write about your picture.



### Card 8 Scene Writing

## TEACHER TIP – Scene Writing:

Make Card 8 by colouring, laminating and cutting out each scene. These are great writing prompts for beginning writers as there are many words for support. Encourage students to try to hear and record sounds in words as they shouldn't be dependent on copying alone. Copying Writing is the lowest form of learning.

1. Choose a scene to write about.

2. Look at the picture.

3. Look at all the labels for the pictures.

4. Think about what you could write about.

5. Try to write in sentences and use the labels for support.

6. Try to write some words by yourself by saying the words and listening to the sounds.
