

## Questioning Task Cards

### Question Game

1. Choose a partner to work with.
2. Read the same book, either individually or together.
3. As you each read record 5 questions to ask your partner.
4. When you have both finished reading take turns to ask the questions.
5. For each question that the person answers correctly they will get one point.
6. The person with the most points is the winner.
7. If there is a disagreement over an answer go back to the book and find evidence.

### Three Questions

1. Work with a partner.
2. Read the same book, either individually or together.
3. As you read think of three questions to ask your partner.
4. You need to ask a question in each category.
5. Take turns to ask each question.
6. Discuss which were the hardest questions to think of.
7. Discuss which were the hardest questions to answer.

<b><u>'Right There'</u></b> questions [Literal questions]	The answer is in the text. It's 'Right There' for you to read.
<b><u>'Think and Search'</u></b> questions [Inferential questions]	Search for clues in the story and think about things the author has hinted at or inferred.
<b><u>'On My Own'</u></b> questions [Evaluative questions]	The answer won't be told in words in the story. You must think of the answer in your head.
